



Michelle Lynn Ussery

March 28, 1974 - September 3, 2021

On Friday, September 3, 2021, Michelle Lynn Ussery, an adored wife, daughter, sister and mother, passed away at Piedmont Newnan Hospital at the age of 47.

Born on March 28, 1974, to George "Marty" Whitten and Theodosia "Theo" Whitten, Michelle was the eldest of four children. In 2009, she married her high school sweetheart, John Ussery, who was her best friend and favorite travel partner. She followed her admiration for the medical field, becoming a radiologist technician and working in several hospitals and clinical offices throughout Alabama and metro-Atlanta. Michelle had numerous hobbies and passions, but among these she loved most were baking, hiking, rooting for the Falcons, decorating for Christmas, and spending time with family.
