Mitchell Cole Brown, age 34, of Newnan, GA, passed away on Tuesday, September 30th at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. He was born on September 23rd, 1991, to his mother, Debbie Brown, in Alabama. He is preceded in death by his grandfathers, Mitchell Lee Brown and Bob Miller.

Mitchell grew up in Sharpsburg, GA, and graduated from Northgate High School. Growing up, he was known for his mischievous pranks and a radiant smile that he always wore- perhaps his best feature. Young Mitch frequently greeted friends and strangers alike with a cheerful "Howdy, Neighbor," a habit that became the foundation of a lifetime of making people feel welcome. His love showed up not just in the grand moments but in a thousand everyday acts of love; Mitch himself, showed up for them every day with the same steady devotion that defined his life. 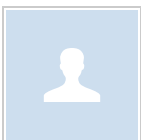
