Mr. Monroe Milam Yarbrough, age 74, of the Welcome Arnco community passed away peacefully at his home on Wednesday, September 14, 2016. Mr. Yarbrough was born in Arnco Mills on June 14, 1942 to the late Arthur Monroe Yarbrough and Hattie Leola Milam. Mr. Yarbrough started his working life in Arnco Mill in 1958 as a weaver and worked there until 1961 when he graduated high school and left to join the U.S. Airforce.
