DIRECTIONS TO EAST ARMUCHEE BAPTIST CHURCH AND CEMETERY

From the crossroads of I 285 & I 75 it takes about 2 hours I 75 North toward Chattanooga

A little past Calhoun

Take the ramp at Hwy 136, exit 320, (the 2nd Resaca exit). Go LEFT over the bridge.

Continue 7 miles on Hwy.136 to a dead end

Go RIGHT onto Hwy. 136 for 8 miles.

You will see and pass Macedonia Baptist Church on your Right, then you come to an intersection with a convenience store on your right and an old store on your Left. This intersection is Villinow, GA. Villinow does not have a post office so everyone's address is LaFayette, GA.

Turn LEFT at this Villinow intersection and go 3 miles to the church on your RIGHT
