Unfortunately, this is not one of Nancy's April Fool's Day pranks. Nancy McLean passed away on October 11, 2024, peacefully in her sleep. Having been born on April 1st, Nancy was a natural prankster and lover of good jokes and passed on only the best jokes to her friends and family. Nancy famously pranked an entire elementary school class by impersonating the teacher who was her sister on April Fool's Day. The resulting prank was so good that many of the students couldn't tell the difference for several hours.

The daughter of Edward Floyd Galloway and Gladys (Updyke) Galloway, Nancy grew up in rural southern Michigan on a dairy farm near Reading. She attended a one-room schoolhouse with many of her cousins that was located on her uncle's farm. On the farm she developed her love of animals and learned to help people in need, be it family members or people in the community. Later in life Nancy supported friends and family experiencing difficult times by regularly offering temporary accommodations. Nancy also became a regular blood donor at the local Red Cross eventually donating over ten and half gallons.

Nancy graduated from Hillsdale College in 1959 and received her Master's degree at Middle Tennessee State in 1984. She was a career teacher and was known for championing the underdogs in her classroom. She taught in Sturgis, MI schools, Howe Military Academy, Howe, IN, and the last 21 years

of her career in Newnan, GA at the Elm Street Elementary School.

Nancy was preceded in death by her sister, Betty Garman and brother, James Galloway. She is survived by her three sons, Jon (Sharon), Tom (Marlin), and Steve (Anne) Moyer; their father and her former husband, Wendell Moyer; and her former husband, Mark McLean.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, October 28, 2024 at 10:00 AM at Faith Lutheran Church, 575 Fischer Rd., Sharpsburg, GA 30277. A Celebration of Life will be scheduled for the spring of 2025 in Reading, MI.
