*I am greatly saddened to see Nora on the obituary page today. I had no idea that she had passed. Nora and I dated starting in 1969 when I attended Georgia Tech. I was lucky enough to stop her in her Camaro in front of the fraternity house one night as she and a friend drove by. Boy, was she good -looking. But I can tell by y'all's comments below that you knew that. After that night, we saw each other off and on for several years. As beautiful as she was, that feature paled in comparison to her sweet heart, sharp wit, and wonderful personality. When we met, she was doing secretarial work for a law firm in Jonesboro and lived in south Atlanta. We had pet names for each other and I called her Natalie because she favored Natalie Wood. One time, my fraternity was choosing a girl to represent it as an homecoming queen contestant. Some of the guys offered up their girlfriends or wives and the brothers knew all of them. I raised my hand and said, "I'm dating someone who will do better in a contest than any of your girls." Nora won the vote sight-unseen. The next day, I put a picture of her wearing a bikini on our bulletin board. I took her to the interviews of local celebrities. One was the manager of the Atlanta Playboy Club. Those of you who knew Nora probably knew that she would have been uncomfortable in a situation like that and she stayed very low key during the event. She ended up as runner-up for overall GT homecoming queen that year (1969) which she would rather have been anyway. The last time I saw Nora was the week before I got married. She was living in a nice trailer in Canton. It had been a few years since I had seen her and she caused me to have second thoughts of getting married. I won't get into that. If anyone who knew her well reads this post and wouldn't mind contacting me, I surely would like to hear about her life from 1977 to 2013. My number is 970-249-0981. My wife of 48 years died of Alzheimers this past March and I was searching the web to see if Nora might be findable. My heart aches.*
