Norine Ward Duncan, 86 of Sharpsburg, passed away Sunday, January 5, 2025, at Piedmont Newnan Hospital surrounded by her children and grandchildren. She was born August 18, 1938, in White, GA to the late Mr. Lud Lankford Ward & Mrs. James Norine Smith Ward. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Lankford Ward and son, Don Duncan.

Norine was a longtime Coweta County resident who worked over 30 years as a radiology secretary at Coweta General, Peachtree Regional, and Piedmont Newnan Hospitals.
