Mr. Noriyasu "Nori" Sakaki, 75, of Sharpsburg, passed away on Wednesday, April 1st 2026, at his residence. He was born February 18th, 1951, in the Chiba prefecture of Japan to the late Jishiro & Hana Sakaki.

Nori grew up in Shin-Kemigawa, Japan, where he studied mechanical engineering. In 1975, at the age of 24, his employer relocated him to Newport Beach, California, where he would spend five transformative years. During this time, he met Rosalia, who would become his wife.

Though work obligations required Nori to return to Japan, he maintained his connection with Rosalia across the distance. In 1981, Nori returned to California, and the couple married. Rosalia then moved to Japan with Nori, and they spent four years together in Nagano before relocating to Peachtree City, Georgia, in 1985, where they would build their life and raise their family. Throughout his life, Nori cherished traveling, nature, fishing, gardening, and cooking.
