Patisue Jackson (Pati) Age 94, formerly of Atlanta, Georgia, entered into the nearer presence of God at 1:20 AM on Thursday, January 2, 2020.

Patisue is survived by her older sister, Juliette Jackson Worth also of Newnan, Georgia and her younger brother, Emmette Grant Jackson of Hingham, Massachusetts as well as several nephews and nieces in Georgia, Alabama and Massachusetts.
