December 23, 1949 - May 1, 2023

Our family sadly lost our beloved sister and aunt, Patricia Ann Causey, most commonly known as Aunt T, on Monday, May 1, 2023. Patricia was born to Felton and Edith Causey on December 23, 1949, in Newnan, Ga.

After graduation, Patricia attended Reinhardt University for her bachelor's degree and became an educator in the Coweta County School System. She started her teaching career at Eastside Elementary and then East Coweta High School. She later earned a master's degree from West Georgia University. She had an impressive career at University of West Georgia, where she was a cherished colleague and friend to many, retiring as Assistant Dean of Students in 2012.

Patricia loved traveling, her cats & dogs, and was an avid reader of books, but nothing compared to her love for her family. Her pride and joy were her nieces, nephews, great-nieces, and great-nephews. Her most treasured memories were among her sisters and family at the beach. Patricia rarely missed a school event, awards day, or athletic game throughout the years. She was an unwavering supporter and a ferocious champion for her loved ones, as evident from her pride in displaying their accomplishments on her Facebook page often.

Patricia is survived by her sisters Susan (Denny) Heard, Carol (Jim) Coxe,

and Janie (Randy) Owens; nephews Ryan (Michelle) Owens, Brett (Catie) Heard, and Josh (Ashley) Owens; nieces Joni (Todd) Scarbrough, Julie (Dameon) Owens-Binion; and nine great nieces and nephews.

Patricia is preceded in death by her parents, Felton and Edith Causey, and her nephew Hunter Scarbrough.

I had just graduated from college and was a bit afraid of her at first... but the more I got to know her I got to see her wickedly funny sense of humor, her ability to listen coach and teach, her love of cats 🐱, and most importantly her heart of gold. I once overdrew my checking account by less than \$3. Not realizing that I had, I had paid several bills by check.
