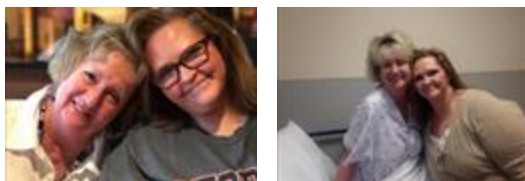
“ You know you are a true friend when the mother of your friends scolds you... lol

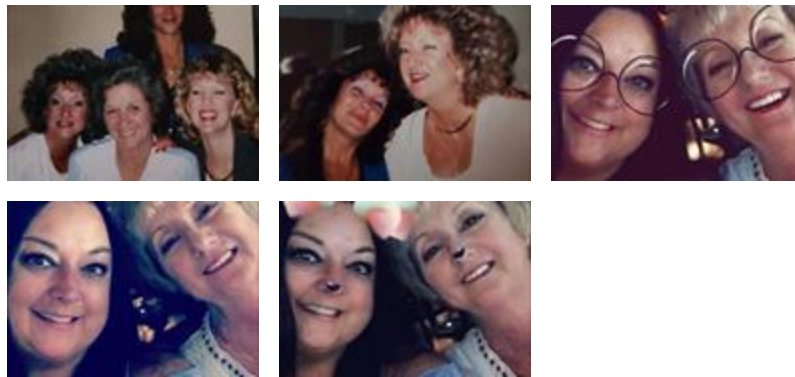

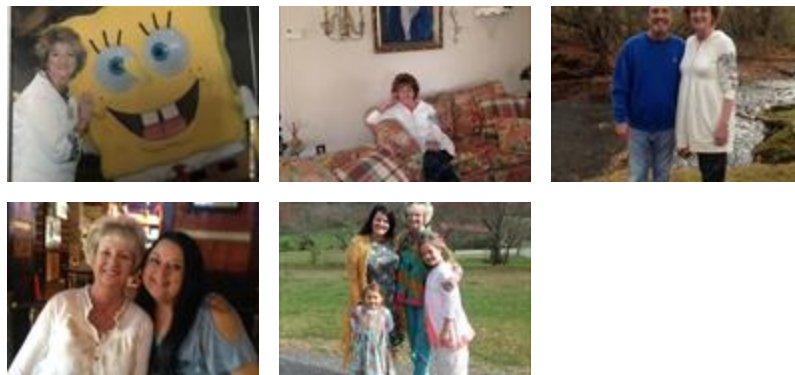
