Patty graduated high school in St. Pete, afterwards attending the University of Indiana where she obtained a degree in Special Education. She became a teacher with the Burwell Program in Newnan, Georgia and taught in the same classroom for 29 years. Patty had a profound impact on everyone she made connections with, and her students were the biggest beneficiary. Even after her retirement, Patty became a substitute teacher.
