Paula was an active member of Trinity Baptist Church where she was active in many ministries. She touched the lives of many young people during her 25 years of driving a school bus for the Coweta County School System. Her dedication to the students who rode her bus did not end when they were dropped off-annually she volunteered to assist the students at the Coweta County Special Olympics. In February 2014, the doctors told her she had 3 to 6 months to live but she proved them wrong and valiantly battled cancer for another year and eight months. 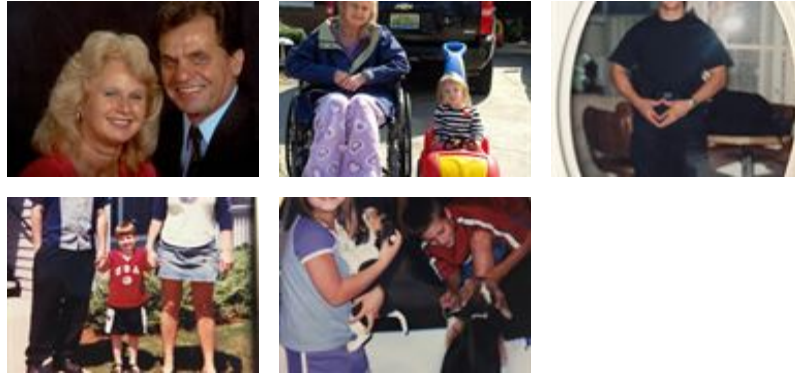
