



Pauline Cavender

July 29, 1918 - January 30, 2009

Pauline Jackson Cavender, 90, of Newnan died Friday, January 30, 2009 after a year-long battle with congestive heart failure. A native of Heard County, she was the second child of the late Joseph & Naomi Hardegree Jackson. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, F. Eugene Cavender, her sister, Virginia Jackson Payton, and her brother, Curtis Jackson.

She moved to Newnan in the 1930's, and except for a few years, lived the remainder of her life there. She was a member of the First Baptist Church. She worked in the Newnan Hosiery Mill, The Alamo Theater, Belk-Gallant, Keheley Florist and Newnan Florist. Until last year, she was often seen around town on her almost-daily three-mile walk. She loved the Braves-even before 1991-and even after 2005. Her passion was her family and especially her grandchildren. All who knew her will miss her energy and her love. For 89 of her 90 years she lived a full and vigorous life.

The funeral is Sunday, February 1, 2009 at 3:30 pm in the chapel of McKoon Funeral Home with Dr. Joel Richardson officiating. Burial will follow at Oak Hill Cemetery. The visitation is Sunday afternoon between 2:00 & 3:30 pm at McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson St, Newnan, GA.
