Philip Larry Henson, 79, of Newnan passed away Tuesday, February 20, 2024. He was born August 31, 1944, in Ellijay, GA to the late James Leonard Henson and Rosa Nell Penland Henson. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his grandson, Philip Tyler Henson.

Philip grew up in north Georgia and was a 1962 graduate of Gilmer County High School. After 27 years, he retired from General Motors Lakewood Assembly Plant. Shortly after retiring, he returned to work at Playtex in Newnan until the plant was closed. He was a longtime member and deacon of Macedonia Baptist Church. Philip was a dedicated Mason for 50 years and was a past master of Sylvan Lodge.

The funeral is at 2:00 pm Tuesday, February 27, 2024, at Macedonia Baptist Church with Dr. John Riley and Rev. Matthew Myers officiating. Burial, with Masonic Rites, will follow at Macedonia Baptist Church Cemetery. The visitation is Monday evening between 5-7 pm at McKoon Funeral Home.

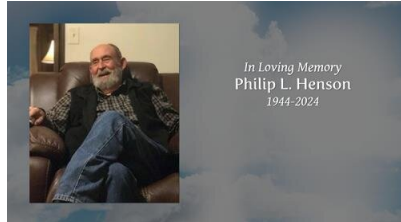
