Mr. Ray Joseph Cornay, Jr. died May 1, 2007 at age 76. He was born January 17, 1931, Lafayette, LA, to the late Ray Joseph Cornay and Katherine Lyman Cornay. Mr. Cornay is survived by his wife of fifty years, Merrill LeBlanc Cornay; his five sons (and their wives): Ray J. Cornay, III (Sherry), Frederick J. Cornay (Julie), Frank S. Cornay (Kathy), Robert L. Cornay (Melissa), and H. Michael Cornay (Beth); and nine grandchildren.
