Rev. Frank G. Garner, 62, of Newnan, GA passed away Friday, September 4, 2009.

Rev. Frank G. Garner was born in Beckley, WV, to the late Hubert & Margaret (Ferguson) Garner on March 31, 1947. He and his wife Runnet just celebrated their 45th wedding anniversary on July 10th. They have one daughter, Tammy Jones, son-in-law, Ken Jones, the Assistant Pastor of New Beginning Baptist Church in Senoia, GA. He has 2 granddaughters, Jordyn and Jensyn Jones. He is also survived by his brothers'; Rev. George (Linda) Garner; Brother, Jimmy (Loretta) Garner; Brother, Arlen (Linda) Garner; sister, Mary Ellen (Bobby) Owen; Sister, Sue (Dave) McKinney; Sister, Kay (Johnny) Chaney. He was a member of Grace Baptist Church in Whitesburg, GA. He spent the last 39 years in the ministry, pasturing, preaching, teaching and the most recent as a representative for Good Samaritan Baptist Missions, Villa Rica, Ga. The mission work is in Central America. He also owned and operated Frank's Construction, in Newnan, for several years.

Mr. Garner was the Pastor of many churches in Georgia and Florida including; Happy Valley Baptist Church in Newnan, Ga., Antioch Baptist Church in Carrollton, Ga. and Holy Ground Church in Carrollton, Ga. He was ordained into the ministry on April 19, 1974, by Bible Baptist Church in Douglasville, Ga. He received his Master of Religious Education from Trinity Theological Seminary Bible College & Institute, Marietta, Georgia.

He was very active in Nursing Home and Radio ministry. He started the
