Colossians 3:24 says, “since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.” In that late night hours of Monday, September 23, 2019 Rev. Paul Stitcher received his reward for his many years of service to his God.

Paul A. Stitcher, Jr., 85, was born July 21, 1934 in Carroll County, GA. Paul was the only son of six children born to the late Paul Augustus Stitcher & Mattie Inez Hutson Stitcher. In addition to his parents, his sisters, Doris Samples, Mable Gaddy, Marilyn Farmer, Rudean Carroll, Merriam Strickland all preceded him in death.

Rev. Stitcher went to Western High School and later in life took several classes at University of West Georgia. At the age of eighteen he went to work for Ford Motor Company where he retired after 30 years of service. Rev. Paul dedicated his life to the Lord servicing as Pastor of Welcome All Baptist Church for eighteen years and West Bethel Baptist Church for 30 years. He led many people to salvation and even on his death bed was witnessing to nurses and visitors. After retiring from West Bethel Baptist Church, Rev. Stitcher joined Arnco Baptist Church where his son, Tim, is pastor.

The funeral is 2:00 o'clock Thursday, September 26, 2019 in the chapel of McKoon Funeral Home with Rev. Tim Stitcher, Rev. Stan Rogers, and Rev. Aaron McCullough officiating. Interment will follow at Forest Lawn Memorial Park. The visitation is Wednesday evening between 6-8 at McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson St, Newnan.

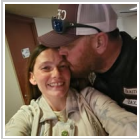
