Richard G. Gebhardt, age 87, died Thursday, December 22, 2016. Mr. Gebhardt, formerly of Troy Hill, Pittsburgh, then Beverly, Mass., then Newnan, GA was a scout-master for twenty years, a 32nd degree mason and a Shriner for 48 years. Mr. Gebhardt was a lay preacher at Bethel Lutheran Church, Pittsburgh, a founder of Prince of Peace Lutheran Church, Beverly, Mass. and an ordained minister of the Universal Life Church. Mr. Gebhardt was employed by Limbach Company, based in Pittsburgh for 43 years; serving in Pittsburgh, Boston, Atlanta, and most major airports in the eastern United States retiring at the age of 61. He was an Administrator for many years and was a Fellow of the Order and Moose of the year in 2004. He was preceded in death by his parents, Richard David Gebhardt and Jessie (Jean) Keillor Gebhardt. He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Mary Anna Gebhardt; a daughter, Karen Gebhardt of Nevada; three sons, Richard and John of Beverly, Mass. and Michael of Lagrange, GA, their spouses, 11 grandchildren and 12 great grandchildren.
