



## Robert Francis Bourque

January 13, 1941 - June 23, 2017

Robert Francis “Bob” Bourque, 76, of Newnan, passed away Friday, June 23, 2017 at his residence.

Born January 13, 1941, in Lynn, Massachusetts he was a son of the late Joseph Alford Bourque and Sara Lena Melanson Bourque. Mr. Bourque was preceded in death by brothers, Father Leo Bourque, SSS, Brother John Bourque, Alford “Al” Bourque, Rene` Bourque and Roland Bourque; and sisters, Loretta Napierski, Marie Moran, and Jeanette Neary.

Bob lived in Lynn, Massachusetts until graduating from Saint John the Baptiste High School in 1961. He attended and graduated from East Coast Aero Tech and then immediately entered the United States Air Force. He was stationed in Lakeland Air Force Base and Charleston Air Force Base. He completed one tour of duty in Vietnam and returned home in 1966. Mr. Bourque was employed by Delta Airlines and retired in 1994 and for the past twelve years had been employed by Auto Color and Finish Masters as an independent delivery driver. He was ill for a very short time and died seven days after being diagnosed with Pancreatic cancer. He was a loving and faithful husband, father, and grandfather. He will be greatly missed.
