Robert Gregory Fegreus, 67, of Grantville, GA formerly of Lincoln Park, MI & Punta Gorda, FL died Saturday, December 20, 2008. He was born January 11, 1941 in Worchester, MA to the late Francis Joseph Fegreus & Shirley Gregory Fegreus.

Mr. Fegreus was retired from the U.S. Navy and was a veteran of the Vietnam War where he served as a medic with the Marines and was wounded in combat and received the Purple Heart. After retiring from the Navy he became an avid golfer and worked as a starter at Canongate's Summergrove Golf Club. He was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church.

The memorial service is Tuesday, December 23, 2008 at 11:00 am at St. Paul's Episcopal Church with Rev. Matt Greathouse officiating. Burial with military honors will follow at Forest Lawn Memorial Park. The visitation is Monday between 3:00 & 8:00 pm at McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson St, Newnan, GA.
