Robert P. "Bob" Keiser, 81, of Newnan, GA passed away Thursday, November 28, 2013 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. He was born June 7, 1932 in Roundtree Township, Morrisonville, Illinois to the late Clarence M. Keiser & Alice Palmer Keiser. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Elizabeth Derrick Keiser.
