Robert M. Osterhout, 61, of Newnan, GA, formerly of Manitou Beach, died on January 12, 2010, at his home. He was born on September 19, 1948, in Sault Ste. Marie, MI, to Robert F. Osterhout & Liela (LaPlaunt) Osterhout. He graduated from Onsted High School, Class of 1967, and served in the U.S. Navy from 1967 to 1972 & 1974 to 1976. He also attended Grand Rapids School of Bible & Music and Calvary Bible College in Kansas City, MO. He graduated in 1987 from Calvary Bible College with a Bachelor of Science degree. He was recognized in 1993 for his work in establishing the volunteer chaplaincy program at Spaulding Regional Hospital, where he worked as a professional baker. Robert was a chaplain at Hartsfield Atlanta International Airport and a member of Grace Community Fellowship Church. He was a tribal member of the Chippewa Indians of the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. He was preceded in death by his parents and a younger brother, David.
