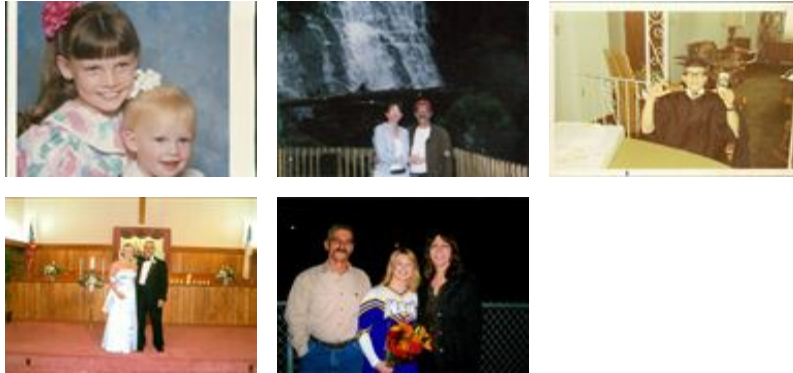

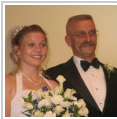
He brought those S'mores. I told him he was going to get me fat. But I didn't refuse them and he would just laugh. I'm going to miss you Ron.

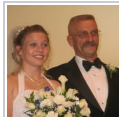

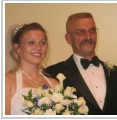
