Ronald Guy, 69, of Palm Bay, Florida, died September 5, 2019 at Advent Hospital in Orlando, Florida surrounded by family. He was born January 21, 1950 in LaGrange, Georgia. Ron was preceded in death by his parents, Joseph McMahon Guy and Billie Ruth Guy Freeman.
