



## Rosemary Ursula Krone

September 10, 1932 - November 5, 2010

Rosemary Ursula Bishop Krone, 78, died on Friday November 5, 2010 at her home in Newnan, GA. She was born September 10, 1932 in Pittsburgh, PA to the late Frank J. Bishop & Anna Rose Gambosh Bishop. After graduating high school, she attended Pennsylvania State University where she earned degrees in Sociology & Marketing. She and her husband married and opened "Krone's Driftwood Lounge & Steakhouse", which they operated for several years in Butler, PA. Mrs. Krone became active in social work through Catholic Social Services & Charities where she faithfully served children and families in her calling as a social worker until her retirement. Through her journeys in helping children, she not only became a mother, she also mentored and sponsored individual high school students, improving their opportunities and enriching their lives. She moved to Newnan in 2005 and was a member of St. George Catholic Church. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by husband, Herbert Curtis Krone.
