June 3, 1937 - April 29, 2024

Mrs. Rosetta Cass entered into eternal rest on Monday April 29, 2024. Rosetta was born on Thursday June 3rd, 1937, in Dagenham, England to Joseph and Rosetta Woody. Rosetta was the matriarch of her family and loved her family with all of heart and was dedicated to her Episcopalian faith.

Rosetta grew up in the suburbs of London and lived through what is known as the London Blitz, living in the total darkness of the nightmarish World War II blackouts.

In 1955 Rosetta took a chance on a prearranged blind date to meet an American Soldier. It was during this chance meeting Rosetta fell head over heels in love with her American Soldier and beloved Harry. In October 1955 Rosetta boarded the SS Flandre on a Transatlantic voyage to meet her one and only true love Harry in the United States for what was to be known as a beautiful love story. Rosetta and Harry married on November 12, 1955, and had a blissful marriage filled with love for over 56 years. During their marriage they had two wonderful sons and traveled the world and eventually calling Heidelberg Germany home.

Through Rosetta's love her family flourished. Rosetta started her marriage as homemaker making certain her son's needs were taken care of and she protected both boys to her fullest extent. As the boys grew and became more independent, Rosetta began a career with the United States Army as a Civil Servant and retired in 1994.

Rosetta enjoyed traveling across Europe with her favorite vacation spot being Berchtesgaden, Bavaria Germany, besides traveling she also loved to shop. Rosetta would shop until she dropped and shared her extensive collection of German Chrystal and Polish Pottery with her family.

Rosetta was a Daughter of the Kings serving her faith and community within the Episcopal Church, doing the many varied tasks, such as bookkeeping, scheduling and ironing of the church linens to keep the small Heidelberg Chapel afloat.

After the loss of her beloved Harry in 2012, Rosetta became actively involved with the San Antonio Chapter of the Gold Star Wives Club.

Rosetta is preceded in death by her parents, brother, and beloved husband. Rosetta is survived by her Son's Kenneth (Lina), Gary (Terri), Four Grandchildren; Victoria, Kimberly, Philip, and Brittany, plus four Great Granddaughters and Two Great Grandsons.
