Bob Perusse, a loving husband, father and grandfather, peacefully slipped from this life into eternity in the early morning hours of December 26, 2013. He was born in Lawrence, Massachusetts on September 6, 1937 and was the son of the late Rudolph L. and Bertha Marie Trembley Perusse. He later moved to Connecticut with his family during his formative years. He served in the United States Army and was stationed at Fort McPherson and that's where he met his wife-to-be, Beverly Anne Evans. They had been married 49 years at the time of his death. Bob retired from Delta Airlines where he had worked in the purchasing department. Bob was a quiet, gentle soul who was most comfortable blending into the background – never wanting to be the center of attention.
