



Samuel "Don" McClain

Samuel Donnie McClain, age 79, passed away Friday, January 20, 2017 at Piedmont Fayetteville Hospital surrounded by family. He was born July 17, 1937 to the late James Homer McClain and Grace Ashley McClain.

Mr. McClain retired after 23 years at Abrams Fixture Corporation and then became a personal business owner, providing whirlpool tubs for many home builders in the Newnan area until full retirement.
