It is with heavy hearts that we share the passing of Sandra "Sandy" Little Cooper, better known to most everyone as "Maw", 78, beloved wife, mother, and grandmother on Thursday, April 24, 2025. Sandy passed away at home surrounded by family.

Sandy was born to the late Gordon A. Little and Clara "Cricket" Pitts Little in Atlanta, Ga. on April 9, 1947. In addition to her parents, she is preceded in death by her brother Rick Little and her loving husband Claude Gary Cooper, Sr. to whom she married on August 30, 1975. They lived the majority of their life together in Newnan, Ga.

Sandy grew up in Fairburn, Ga. Where she graduated from Lake Shore High School.
