



Shirley Juanita Enloe

June 23, 1937 - April 19, 2006

Juanita Ard Enloe, 68, of Atlanta died peacefully on Wednesday, April 19, 2006 after a prolonged battle with lung disease. Born on June 23, 1937 in Savannah, GA., and raised in Chester S.C., she was voted "Wittiest" by her senior class at Chester High School. Both her extraordinary sense of humor and her ability to connect with people from all walks of life were testaments to Juanita's intelligence, vibrant personality and profound caring for others. An Atlanta resident for 45 years, Juanita was a flight attendant with Eastern Airlines for 15 years, after which she retired to raise her daughter, Jennifer Enloe, a graduate of Woodward Academy and Randolph-Macon Woman's College. Juanita returned to work in the 1980's as a client services representative for Laboratory South and later Quest Diagnostic Laboratories, where she received multiple awards for excellence. A memorial service to celebrate her life will be held on Sunday, May 7, 2006 at 2:00 PM at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Newnan, GA. The Reverend Russell Kendrick will officiate.
