Sidney Brent Hulsey, 47, of Newnan, husband of Susan Marie “Susie” McLoughlin Hulsey passed away June 26, 2017.

Born in Atlanta, May 21, 1970, he was a son of Claude Bryan Hulsey and Brenda Louise Konkle Hulsey. He grew up in Stone Mountain and was a 1988 graduate of Redan High School. He attended the University of Georgia and was a member of the Chi Phi Fraternity.

Brent got involved in the restaurant business at a young age. His high school part time job was in a restaurant and he continued after college to work in fine dining in Atlanta at places such as Toulouse, The Park Bench and Pano's and Paul's. In 1994 Brent married Susan Marie McLoughlin of County Clare, Ireland and in 2003 he and his family moved to Newnan where he was owner/operator of Vinnie R's Italian Restaurant. When the family closed the restaurant eight years later, Brent began a career with Kroger. He took on his new job with great enthusiasm and had recently been named Manager of the Douglasville Kroger.

The funeral is Saturday, July 1, 2017 at 11:00 AM at Crossroads Church 154 Campus at Thomas Crossroads, 2564 Highway 154, Newnan, GA 30265.
