September 24, 1939 - September 8, 2024

Silvestro Antonino Messina, better known by family and friends as "Sal", passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 8, 2024, at the age of 84.

Born on September 24, 1939, in Brooklyn, New York, Sal was a pillar of strength and kindness. He cherished his role as a father and grandfather, finding immense joy in their accomplishments and happiness. His love was a guiding light in their lives, and his wisdom and support were unwavering. Throughout 60 years of marriage to the love of his life, Ann, they created a home filled with warmth, laughter, and an enduring bond that withstood the tests of time. Their love story was one of mutual respect and cherished moments, and his presence will be profoundly missed. Strong in his faith Sal lived his life with grace and conviction. His faith was his cornerstone, and he embraced the teachings of the Church with sincerity and reverence. His contributions to his parish and community reflected his deep belief in service and compassion; as a longtime member of St Vincent de Paul Society, Knights of Columbus, and St George Church's Respect Life Ministry. His years as a New York City police officer were marked by commendations for peacefully resolving conflicts.

The funeral mass celebrating Sal's life is Tuesday, September 17, 2024, at 10:30 A.M. at St. George Catholic Church, 771 Roscoe Road, in Newnan, with Father Stephen Lyness officiating. Sal will be laid to rest following the service

at Forest Lawn Memorial Park, where military honors will be rendered for his honorable service to his country. The family will receive friends on Monday evening from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM, at McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson Street, in Newnan. The family also invites friends to attend the Divine Mercy service beginning at 5:30 PM on Monday.
