Stephen "Steve" Ray Boyd, 53, of Newnan, GA passed away on Sunday, January 14, 2024, after a difficult fight with gastric cancer lasting over a year. He is finally at rest.

He was born in Atlanta, GA on June 4, 1970, to Nelda and Truman Boyd. He was raised in Fayetteville, GA, and was a 1988 graduate of Fayette County High School.

Steve and his wife, Michelle, were married for 22 years. They enjoyed working together in their businesses, traveling, and spending time with friends.
