July 12, 1951 - November 5, 2025

Susan Sewell Hollingsworth, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and friend, 74, of Winter Garden, Florida, passed away on November 5, 2025, at West Georgia Hospice after a valiant fight against lung cancer.

Susan was born July 12, 1951, in Newnan, Georgia, where she lived until 1989, when she moved to Orlando, Florida. She was the daughter of the late Thomas Henry and Lucy Sewell. She retired from the Orange County Public School System after 42 years of teaching, mostly math. During her 42 years of teaching, she taught every grade from Kindergarten to 10th, except for 2nd. 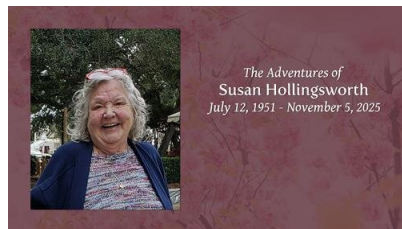
