Dearly loved by his family and friends, Terrell "Terry / TR" Keith Rogers, 67, of Sharpsburg, passed peacefully from this life on May 10, 2025, at his home surrounded by his wife and daughter, as a result of his valiant battle with colon cancer and its complications.

Among many other family members, Terry is survived by his immediate family: his wife of 25 years, JoAnn H. Rogers; his daughter, Jessica Rogers; and his sister, Teresa McWilliams of Dayton, Texas.
