Thomas Laihiff "Tom" Dolan, 81, passed away peacefully on Sunday, April 24, 2024, at his home in Newnan, GA. Tom was born in Lowell, MA, on September 17, 1942, to the late Thomas and Agnes Dolan. In addition to his parents, Tom was preceded in death by his wife, Sharon Alice Dolan.
