Vicki Hill Whitlock, age 69, passed away peacefully at her Senoia home on Tuesday, October 11, 2022. She was born November 22, 1952, in Atlanta, GA to the late Felton and Evelyn Martin Hill.

At the age of 7, she moved to Senoia and remained there until her passing. She was a 1970 graduate of East Coweta High School. At East Coweta she was a cheerleader, a member of the basketball team and the Homecoming Queen. After high school graduation she worked for several years at the Georgia State Patrol headquarters in Atlanta. She then began her 42 year career with the United States Postal Service. She held various positions with the Postal Service and eventually served as Postmaster at the Turin, GA post office for 20 years before she retired in 2014.

Vicki always enjoyed shopping, collecting things and traveling with her friends. During the years her son was in the East Coweta Marching band, she especially enjoyed participating in band fundraisers and volunteered many hours. She even traveled with the band as a chaperone to New York City and London, England. She was an excellent cook and everyone especially enjoyed her fruitcakes. She enjoyed observing Steve farm and raise wonderful vegetable gardens.

The funeral service celebrating Vicki's life is Saturday, October 15, 2022, at

11:00 AM in the chapel of McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson Street, in Newnan. The family will receive friends from 10:00 AM until service time at the funeral home.

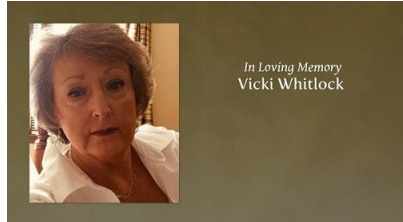
