Before morning, though, she would embark on the most exciting adventure one could imagine and see sights that no one in this world can envision. For, it was during her sleep, that the gentle angels would come down from heaven and carry her gently into the presence of God and all the majesty of her life eternal. Vickie Louise Moon Davis began her time in this world on October 23, 1951 when she was born at Crawford Long Hospital in Atlanta. 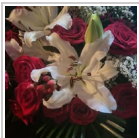

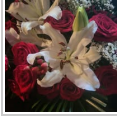
