After she thought she would retire, Violet began working for assisted living facilities and nursing homes. At age 87, she said she enjoyed working with "old people."

When she moved to Newnan, GA and finally retired completely, she kept her sense of humor and loved to tease those close to her.

Violet led a life filled with friends and family, all of whom will miss her deeply.
