Virginia Kent Bigler Jones, 75 of Newnan died peacefully at her home Sunday, October 18, 2009. She was born in Chicago, Illinois to the late Hugh Bigler & Sue Proctor Bigler. At an early age she moved to Birmingham, Al. where she spent her childhood and early adult life. She later moved to Jacksonville, Fl where she taught German & French in the Duvall County School System, until her retirement. She was an active member of San Jose Episcopal Church and was a member of the Jacksonville Symphony Orchestra Choir and the Friday Musicale. Her first retirement years were spent volunteering in the Jacksonville Museums and in her church and community as well. In 2003 she relocated to Newnan to be near her daughter where she was an active member of St Paul's Episcopal Church. She will be remembered as a fabulous teacher and Ambassador of Language and Culture by students throughout the world.
