



Wallace Miller Glover

July 14, 1948 - December 25, 2008

Mr. Wallace Glover, age 60, of Newnan, Georgia, died peacefully at his home surrounded by his family on Christmas day after a brief battle with melanoma. Mr. Glover was born on July 14, 1948, in Newnan, Georgia to the late John Littleton Glover and Margaret Miller Glover. Wallace attended Newnan High School and graduated from The Bolles School in Jacksonville, Florida in 1966. He was a graduate of the University of Georgia in 1970. He was a member of Kappa Alpha Order. At the time of his death, he was the owner of Coweta-Fayette Title Group, Inc. On May 28, 1977, Wallace married his wife, Kay Hanson Glover. They were blessed with three sons, Wallace Miller Glover, Jr., Michael Hanson Glover and Kelley Carter Glover. His family and his golf game were his passions. Wallace was a generous and devoted husband and father who loved coaching his children in soccer, baseball, basketball and golf. He was an avid sports fan who instilled in his children a love of competition and all things related to sports. Wallace will be forever missed by those who knew and loved him. He is survived by his wife of 31 years, Kay, and by his children Mr. and Mrs. Wallace Miller Glover, Jr. of Savannah, Georgia, Mr. Michael Hanson Glover of New Orleans, Louisiana and Mr. Kelley Carter Glover of Charleston, South Carolina; brother, Mr. and Mrs. J.
