William G. "Bill" Ammerman, 66, died Wednesday, March 24, 2010, surrounded by his devoted wife and children. He was born February 19, 1944 in Iuka, Mississippi, grew up in Missoula, Montana, and made his home in Newnan for the past 20 years. His father, Marion Russell Ammerman, died when Bill was a teenager and his mother, Opal McCrae Ammerman Haynes married Walter LeRoy Haynes who raised Bill as his own son. Bill was a Vietnam Veteran and served in the Army as a gunner on UH1-D Helicopters. He attended the University of Montana and finished at East Coast Aerotec in Boston, MA. He began work in with Northeast Airlines in 1970 in Miami where he also worked with the Miami-Dade Police Academy. In 1973, Delta bought Northeast Airlines and he transferred to the Atlanta Hub where he retired in 2001. Bill had many talents and was a passionate "Sharp Shooter" for many years in the Southeast.

In June 1985 he married Betty Frank Houston and they shared 25 wonderful years traveling and sharing a love for each other.

The funeral is Saturday, March 27, 2010 at 3:00 pm in the chapel of McKoon Funeral Home with Rev. Asa Mangham officiating.
