Mr. William "Bill" Junior Roe, 92, of Marietta, GA, formerly of Newnan, GA, passed away Friday, April 24, 2026 at his home. He was born October 15, 1933 in Humeston, IA to the late William "Will" and Olive Helt Roe.

Bill grew up in Humeston, IA and was a 1952 graduate of Humeston High School. He married Shirley Windsor Roe on March 3, 1954. Mr. Roe served his country in the U.S. Army for two years. Bill was a proud graduate of Simpson College in Indianola, IA where he majored in Business Administration. After graduation he moved to Newton, IA to work for the Maytag Company as an accountant. He worked for Maytag his entire career, retiring as Vice President and Controller at Admiral in 1995.

After the death of Shirley in 2002, Bill was blessed to meet Mary Ann Shiple. They were married March 13, 2004 and enjoyed many happy years together. Bill was a devoted Christian who served many years as a Deacon in his local churches as they moved around the country. In his spare time, Bill enjoyed playing golf and bridge. He volunteered at the Habitat for Humanity rehab store as the "lighting guy" for many years. He also coached his sons in baseball and served as President of the Little League in Newton, IA. He enjoyed following the Atlanta Hawks, Braves and Iowa Hawkeyes.

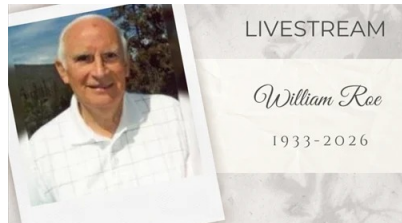
