



William Henry Crowley

May 3, 1920 - September 24, 2014

Mr. William Henry Crowley died peacefully at his home on September 24, 2014 with his loving wife, Polly, by his side. He was born on May 3, 1920 to the late Thomas James Crowley and Mary Lipscomb Crowley in Macon, Georgia. "Bill" grew up in Macon where he attended public school and was an active member of the Vineville Methodist Church. He attended The Citadel and then Mercer University until drafted into the Army.

Bill dedicated several years of military service to his country spending one year in Panama, two years in Honduras, and one year at Fort McClellan in Anniston, Alabama.

After his military service, Bill was employed by Pepsi Cola in Macon. While visiting relatives in Newnan he met Polly Cook. After a short engagement, the two married on April 27, 1946 at what is now Hillcrest Funeral Home.

The Crowleys lived in Macon and Dublin before moving to Newnan in 1951 where Bill soon took over his father-in-law's hardware business. After the business was sold he continued to work for a few more years for Johnson Hardware Company.

After retiring, Bill worked several months each year in the Coweta County Tax Office. He spent many hours in his workshop where he crafted many beautiful wood items. He also pursued his love of hunting and fishing. The Crowleys enjoyed traveling and took many trips around the country and the world.

Preceding Bill in death were his parents and his brother "TJ".
