In 1970 he opened his own franchise Wishbone Fried Chicken as well as his own commissary. He had four stores in Riverdale, College Park,

Decatur and Atlanta. Then in 1982 Carl started C&D Coffee and Vending, Inc. Then his children joined in and worked by his side building a family business.

Carl loved people and never met a stranger. He loved to ride motorcycles, time at the lake with his kids and their friends and just being with family. After retirement he loved being on his lawn mower, working in the yard and feeding and watching birds. He was a hard worker and kind, loving, compassionate, giving, supportive father and grandfather.
