



## William Lee Sewell

June 29, 1918 - December 5, 2020

Mr. William Lee Sewell, 102, of Newnan, formerly of Marietta, passed away Saturday, December 5, 2020 at his daughters home in Newnan. Lee was born June 29, 1918 in Newnan, GA. He was one of eight children of the late William Pope Sewell and Nora Dee Sewell. In addition to his parents, his wife of 73 years, Emily Watkins Sewell, preceded him in death. Also preceding him in death are his sisters, Gladys Sewell (Hyde), Elizabeth Sewell (Parham), Annie Sewell (Parham), Dorothy Sewell (Watkins), Sara Sewell (Stewart) and her brother, Charles Thomas Sewell.
