



Wilma Higgins Wright

December 25, 1933 - December 14, 2019

Mrs. Wilma Wright, age 85 of Newnan, died December 14, 2019. She was born in Coweta County on December 25, 1933 to the late Wilber J. Higgins and Mollie R. Higgins. She was preceded in death by Dan, her beloved husband of 54 years. She grew up in the mill village at East Newnan and graduated from Newnan High School and Perry Business School. She spent her career at American Thread Company, West Point-Pepperell, and Newnan Utilities, where she retired with over 30 years of service as Commission Secretary and Treasurer. Music was an important part of her life, and she was quick to share her talents with two Sunday School classes at Central Baptist Church and at church services throughout the area. She was a member of Central Baptist Church for over 50 years and was a member of the NGO of First Baptist Church for many years. In retirement, she and Dan found great joy in traveling with the senior groups at both churches. She is survived by her sons, Gordy Wright and his wife Julie of Conyers, and Greg Wright of Newnan; and grandchildren Stephen Wright and Elizabeth Wright.
