



Wolfgang Wendt

December 17, 1957 - May 19, 2025

Wolfgang Wendt, a long-time resident of Senoia, Georgia, passed away at Emory Hospital in Atlanta on Monday, May 19th. Wolfgang was born and raised in Erfenbach, Germany, a district of Kaiserslautern, in the Rhineland-Pfalz. He was the son of Jenny and Siegfried Wendt. Wolfgang was a proud graduate of the Pfaff Industriemaschinen GmbH technical education program for industrial machinery in Kaiserslautern, Germany, that led to a lifelong career in industrial sewing automation. After he finished his technical education and did his military service, Pfaff transferred Wolfgang to its U.S. subsidiary in Atlanta. At the time of his death, he was the Sales Director, Apparel, at DAP America, Inc. in Norcross.

A colleague aptly described him as a, "German through and through - direct, with a dry sense of humor, deeply caring but rarely shows it, stubborn, passionate about soccer and beer, and endlessly loyal to his hometown."

Wolfgang is survived by his wife Lynne, his daughter Katharine and her husband Harrison Stewart, his son Christian, his brother and sister-in-law Jurgen and Eva Wendt, of Pforzheim, Germany, and their children Stephan and Tabea and their families.

A Celebration of Life will be held on June 1st at the Stone Lodge at Marimac Lakes Park in Senoia, between 1-5PM. A funeral and interment service will

be held at the Protestant Church in Erfenbach, Germany, at a later date.
