



Wyatt Bradley Kirby

Wyatt Bradley Kirby, age 84, passed away peacefully on February 16, 2025, at his home in Sharpsburg, Georgia, surrounded by his family. He was born on October 2, 1941, in LaGrange, Georgia, a son of the late Gay and Angie Bradley Kirby.
